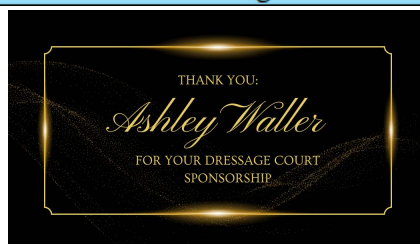

2026 IALHA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Rules & Information

1. **USEF:** The 2026 IALHA Nationals is a US Equestrian Federation licensed competition. Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specification of the current Federation rule book, will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The rules of the Federation take precedence over the rules of any other association. Exhibitors are encouraged to refer to the current Federation Rule Book, which is available at www.usef.org. A Federation Steward approved by the Show Committee shall be present to administer these rules at the show.
2. **IALHA:** Owners and their horses must be members of the IALHA Association and USEF to participate in the Show and must be current with USEF Safe Sport Initiative. Non-owner exhibitors (Jr. Exhibitor/Senior) may purchase a IALHA Show Pass and a USEF Show Pass to compete and must be processed online. Amateur Exhibitors must be members of USEF & be current with the USEF Safe Sport Initiative.
3. **OPPORTUNITY CLASSES:** Will be conducted in accordance with USEF rules and specifications. Opportunity classes will be open to all breeds. There is no USEF membership requirement or drug fees for exhibitors and/or horses entering only Opportunity Classes. Exhibitors and/or horses **may cross-enter** between opportunity and recognized classes if eligible.
4. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, and to cancel award prizes, without claims for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes; and to change judges or other officials. Class Schedules: The tentative Class Schedule is included in this booklet. Final schedule will be available at the show.
5. **SHOW OFFICIALS:** In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one who was officially designated in the prize list, according to USEF rules.
6. **HORSE SHOW OFFICE:** will be open Wednesday from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM. The office will open one hour prior to the first class each day and will remain open for 30 minutes after the last class each day.
7. **RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless IALHA, USEF, AHA, Show Management, their officers, respective directors, agents, employees or representatives against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against IALHA, USEF, AHA, Show Management or their officers, respective directors, agents, employees or representatives by reason of any such claim, Exhibitor, upon notice covenants to defend such action or proceedings by counsel, acceptable to IALHA, USEF, AHA or Show Management. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property.
8. **DISCIPLINE:** Exhibitors are cautioned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver or their families will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove an owner, lessee, trainer, groom, horse, rider, driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Show management will be charged with the responsibility of enforcing all USEF rules. Questions not covered herein shall be decided by Show Management, whose decision shall be final.
9. **INDEMNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the World Equestrian Center, IALHA, its officers, the Show, The Show Committee, Show Official nor any of its sponsors will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify the above-mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. THE SUBMITTING OF AN ENTRY FORM TO THE SHOW SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.
14. **PROTEST:** Must be filed in accordance with the USEF rules and be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 for members or parent /guardian of a junior exhibitor and \$300 for non-members which will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained (See GR603 (d)).
15. **PARKING:** No trailers or vehicles will be allowed to be parked in barn area. Trailers must be parked in designated Trailer Parking areas.
16. **ARENA:** Indoor Arena 6 will open on Wednesday AM. **NO LUNGEING HORSES IN THE INDOOR ARENA.** Sizes 171' x 530' – GGT fiber/silica sand Footing. No person will be permitted to enter the arena, upon start of show, except participants in class, judges and their assistants, show photographer and assistant, show officials and staff. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena unless summoned by the judge.
17. **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:** by the Show Veterinarian or Farrier outside the ring on a Private Fee Basis. The name and phone number of vet posted at show office and barn office.
18. **CALLS FOR CLASSES:** Classes called promptly. Two minute clock begins when the gate opens, the in-gate **MUST** be closed at the end of 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring (GR310.1) Exhibitors entering the same horse in back to back classes, should arrange a tack hold with the paddock. Maximum 3 minutes allowed. Always check-in with paddock master. Problems with mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. Responsibility of exhibitor to be sure his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry calls, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed on the basis of a PA malfunction.
19. **AGE OF INDIVIDUALS:** For show purposes, individual's age on December 1 shall be maintained throughout the entire year. Individuals born December 1 assume the greater age of that date.
20. **INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW:** Failure to settle indebtedness will be barred from taking part USEF Recognized Shows until settlement is

made. USEF (GR1508). Remedies available to the show under USEF rules for non-collect ability of checks show management will assess a fee of \$100.00 if a check is returned unpaid. All fees will be settled at time of checkout.

21. **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** The Show Committee and the Management reserve the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entry, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and remove from the grounds any individual, stable or both without claim for damages. The submitting of an entry form to the show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth. See USEF GR1509.1
22. **ENTRIES:** All owners, riders, drivers and handlers MUST have Current USEF, IALHA, and WDAA memberships (if applicable). The entry blank provides space for signatures, address of the trainer, owner or agent, rider, driver, handler of each entry. Under the age of 18 may not sign as trainer, USEF GR 906-909. **ALL MONEY MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM AND BE PAID BEFORE NUMBERS CAN BE ISSUED (NO OPEN CHECKS. ALL ENTRIES SENT WITH AN OPEN CHECK WILL BE CHARGED A POST ENTRY FEE PER HORSE!!).** Absolutely no numbers will be given out without all card and papers when you check in with the show office. Incomplete entries will be assessed a \$25 fee.
23. An **OPEN/SIGNED CHECK** will be required to add any classes or fees at the show if not using a credit card. Any additional charges must be paid before leaving the show grounds. Any unpaid charges will be assessed a \$25.00 service fee. Failure to pay within 30 days will be considered an unsportsmanlike act and may result in actions taken against such conduct in accordance with USEF rules. There will be a \$100 charge for any checks returned or declined credit cards.
24. **VET INSPECTION:** All horses are subject to physical inspection by the Show Vet as a safeguard against contagious disease. All horses must be serviceably sound, except Equitation Classes. In case of suspected unsoundness, if the judge so desires, have the animal inspected by the Show Vet & that decision shall be final. No exhibitor may use another vet's statement.
25. **HEALTH CERTIFICATES:** Licensee will monitor the required Health Certificates and Coggins test information of all animals entering WEC and the Licensed Areas as directed by the Florida Department of Agriculture. Health records required are as follows: 14-day health certificate including in-state horses; 12-month negative Coggins record; EHV1 and EHV4 - Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering WEC. It is noted and accepted that random inspections for such information can be ordered at any time by Owner and/or Operator.
26. **STALLS:** 12x12 permanent and made of concrete block, fully matted with fans and doors. Exhibitors are required to rent one stall per horse and each horse must be assigned an individual stall (except for broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted except with the express consent of the Barn Manager. Show management will assign stalls. Requests for stabling together must be made by sending entries in together. Any stalls not used will be subject to a 100% cancellation penalty.
27. **BEDDING:** Please preorder bedding. Feed and bedding are purchased directly through [WEC](#). **No outside bedding is permitted. Bedding other than that purchased from WEC will be charged a \$30.00 removal fee per stall.** Manure MUST be placed in designated manure bins. No trash in manure bins and No manure in trash bins! Tack and horse stalls that are found with trash, personal items and debris are subject to a **\$50 clean up fee PER STALL PER WEC**. This does not include shavings/manure in horse stalls.
28. **POST ENTRIES: Pre-Entries close on September 23.** Entries postmarked after this date will automatically be considered Post Entries and assessed the post entry fee as shown in the fee schedule. A United Postal Service postmark will take precedence over postmarks from private meters, etc. Extra classes for pre-entered horses will not be post entries. Entry blanks must be completed and returned before closing date. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER SEPTEMBER 15 – please enter online at www.ringsideproductionsllc.com.**
29. **REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will be made prior to the closing date except for the Office Fee. No refunds after the closing date.
30. **ENTRY AND SCRATCH POLICY:** Entries being added MUST be made by the end of the session prior to the session being entered. **Horses entering the ring without prior entry in office will be charged \$10 ride through gate fee.**
31. **PENALTY POLICY:** In the event the IALHA National Show, management or officials are fined by any organization owing to an exhibitor's infraction of the rules or requirements, said fine will be charged to the exhibitor plus a 10% penalty.
32. **PETS:** All pets to be crated or on a leash at all times while at a USEF Recognized event per USEF rules. Crates may not be in the barn aisleway; they must be contained in a stall.
33. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
34. **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:** The rated Sections of this Competition are official USEF point competitions for the USEF National and USEF Service Company Zone Horse of the Year Awards Programs. Exhibitors encouraged to read the USEF Rule book to review descriptions and judging specifications for classes entered.
35. **SHARPS CONTAINERS:** Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. **Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition.** If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. GR1210.4.
36. **PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** In accordance with USEF rules, all juniors riding in Hunt Seat Equitation Over Fences and Not to Jump, Hunter Over Fences and Jumper classes must wear protective headgear passing applicable ASTM standards (must be stamped inside helmet) while riding in designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds.

37. **DRESSAGE EXHIBITORS** please refer to USEF DR 120 for protective headgear rules.
38. **FOOD SERVICE:** Available on the grounds.
39. **NEW IN 2024: PER GR1215.4:** For 6 consecutive hours overnight, stabling must have minimal lighting and noise to allow stabled horses adequate rest. *** STABLE LIGHTING WILL BE REDUCED FROM 11PM - 5AM ***
40. **USEF MEMBER STATEMENT:**
Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Class Information

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR: Junior exhibitors shall not have reached their 18th birthday. For horse show purposes, the age of the junior exhibitor on December 1 of the show year shall be maintained throughout the entire year.

AMATEUR: Every rider having reached his/her 18th birthday prior to 12/1 must have in their possession an amateur card issued yearly by USEF or make application for such card at least one hour prior to showing in an Amateur class.

OWNERS CLASSES – Combined ownership is not permitted in Owners or Amateur Owners classes unless all owners are members of the same family. For competition purposes the term “family” includes husband, wife, parent, step-parent, child, brother, step-child, sister, half-brother, half-sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather, and in-laws of the same relations as stated above. Leased horses are not eligible. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor’s family, as defined by USEF GR122. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted). USEF AR101.2

FOR ALL EQUITATION RULES: Refer to USEF RULE 25, 219-225

YOUTH HALTER AND SHOWMANSHIP: STALLIONS CANNOT SHOW.

GREEN RIDER DIVISION: Exhibitors entering these classes cannot cross-enter into any Walk/Trot/Canter, Walk/Jog/Lope classes at this competition.

DRESSAGE AND WESTERN DRESSAGE: Dressage competition will be conducted according to USEF Rules. 2023 USEF Tests and USDF 2023 Introductory Tests will be used. The 2022 WDAA Tests will be used. Official ride times to be posted at the show.

IALHA REQUIREMENTS: All horses must have completed the IALHA Registration and have the certificate to compete at the 2026 IALHA National Show. Horses with pending IALHA Registrations are not approved members of IALHA and are not allowed to compete at the IALHA National Show.

FL “WARNING” – Under Florida law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

WDAA Membership Statement

To be eligible to participate and/or compete as an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer in any Western Dressage class or at any Federation Western Dressage Licensed Competition persons must be active members of WDAA or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition. Exception: WDAA membership or non-member fee is not required at a Lite Licensed competition. Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of an entry under multiple ownership, only one owner need be a Member or pay a non-member fee. The competition is responsible for listing either the active member or the owner that paid the non-member fee in the results. The competitions will be responsible for forwarding a list of the names of individuals who pay non-member fees at the competition to WDAA with the post competition report. Payment of non-member fees for the purpose of competing does not entitle the individual to any privileges of the WDAA membership.

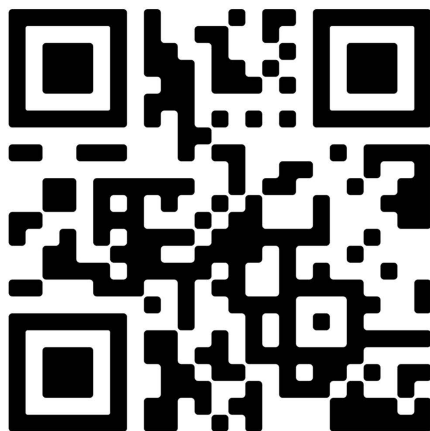

ACADEMY RULES & GUIDELINES

Participants are to compete on horses designated as school horses, or horses that are regularly used in riding lesson program instruction. Classes are not USEF recognized. Horses are encouraged to be lesson horses of any breed and should display the characteristics of such. All breeds of horses are welcome, as long as they display good manners and a quiet disposition.

Riders are MAY NOT cross enter into any non-academy riding classes and are ineligible to compete in ACT classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a Class A Competition. Academy horses with Arabian or IALHA registration papers MAY cross enter into Arabian or IALHA classes. Horses can cross enter in ANY ACT classes, but riders may not cross enter between the Walk/Trot, or the Walk/Trot/Canter classes.

ATTIRE: Riding suits and chaps are not allowed. Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches, or colored jeans are considered appropriate. A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. An ASTM/SEI riding helmet is MANDATORY for all Academy riders aged 12 and under and encouraged for all. Appropriate footwear with a small heel is mandatory.

TACK: A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat and a hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed, and running or German martingales are permitted. Any leverage bit rein is PROHIBITED through the running martingale or used with a German martingale. Tie downs, standing martingales and blinkers are not allowed.

Any horse or rider that is deemed unsafe or is not abiding by these rules may be eliminated by the horse show management.

Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horse's rate in a consistent manner. In the Horsemanship Pleasure classes, quality of the horse is not judged but rather the rider's ability to best display the horse's MANNERS and a pleasurable way of going. Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement.

Headers are allowed in the line up in all walk and walk-trot classes. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses and present themselves to their best advantage.

Horses must possess a current Coggins and Health Certificate, and MUST be provided with entry.

Classes are \$25 each and stalls are \$200.

2. Dressage and Western Dressage entries are due **September 23, 2026**. Entries are limited to the first 65 Rides. All other entries will be placed on a waiting list.
3. Complete USEF Show Entries are due by **September 23, 2026**.
4. Copies of all membership cards for Owner/Horse/Exhibitors (IALHA, USEF, USDF, WDAA) are to be included.
5. Both sides of Horse Registration must be included.
6. The following Horse Health Records are to be included: Required EIA (Negative Coggins), Vaccine Records (Per USEF), 14 day Health Certificate. These must be turned into the Show Office upon arrival at WEC.
7. Please include payment in full or credit card numbers with each entry. In addition, a separate signed check is to be used for close out of the account at close of show.
8. Entrants must include proof of USEF Safe Sport Certification.

Please Note: If you have previously had a payment to IALHA refused or a check returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF), please pay with a money order made out to IALHA. Back/Bridle Numbers will only be released upon full payment of all show fees. Owners are responsible for all fees. Any open accounts remaining at the close of show will be charged to the Trainer named on entry. Entries will not be accepted and processed without the above.

2027 USDF Recognition - The 2027 USDF competition year runs from October 1, 2026 to September 30, 2027. The IALHA National Show Dressage Division competition will be a 2027 USDF Recognized Competition. The 2027 USDF Competition Recognition page has been included for IALHA Dressage competitors.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. 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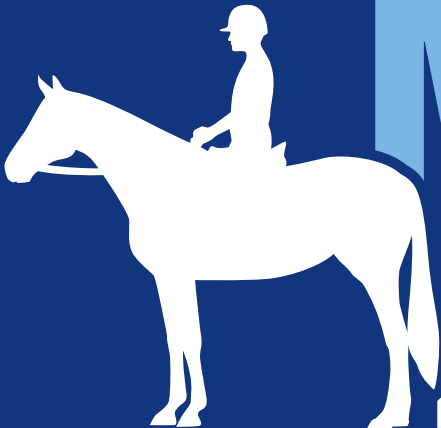

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$100), 5-years (\$400), or life (\$2,000). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$80). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$280) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$55 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$45). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$95. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$140) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

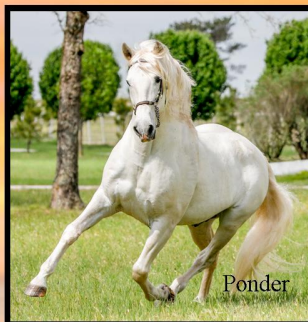
